Stahlbush — Farming Begins with Family

Bill and Karla Chambers started Stahlbush Island Farms with two crops, a piece of land and a passion for good food. Today, the couple still lives in the same house on the farm and manages the business every day. Some may call that old-fashioned; we call it a family farm.





Sustainable Farming at Stahlbush













Soil Health: With each growing season, we use conservation tillage to reduce erosion. We also plant cover crops to return nitrogen to the soil and build organic matter. We even apply digestate from our biogas plant to our fields as it acts as an organic fertilizer, naturally increases microbial activity and builds overall soil health.

Water Conservation: We continue to improve our irrigation: using weather, soil moisture and evapotranspiration data to track water use and needs. We have implemented automation systems that allow us to access real-time data that automatically controls and schedules our irrigation based on the needs of each plant.





Wildlife Habitat and Biodiversity: We plant native species that attract pollinators like bumblebees. We also plant cover crops in the winter that keep the blue herons on the farm year-round. We have a thriving blue heron rookery or habitat on the farm.

Social Responsibility and Employee Well-Being: We have programs and benefits in place for our employees to ensure job satisfaction and fulfillment. We also strive to improve our local community. For instance, we donate one million servings to local food banks every year.

Innovation: We were the first farm ever to be certified sustainable by the Food Alliance. We have always been early adopters of new technology. Stahlbush was the first farm in Oregon to use GPS technology and the first to build a biogas plant that generates electricity using agricultural by-product in North America.

HARNESSING THE POWER OF PLANTS

In 2009, we built a biogas plant on the main farm to convert agricultural by-product into green energy. Today, all of our fruit, vegetable, grain and legume scraps go to the biogas plant. The electricity that is generated from the process is used to power the processing plant.

ELECTRICITY AND BEYOND!

In addition to electricity, the biogas plant also provides:

STEAM for the boilers. **HOT WATER** for sanitation.

HOT AIR to dry our pumpkin seeds. **NATURAL FERTILIZER** that nurtures next year's crops.





ALLERGEN CONTROL & PREVENTION

We understand the seriousness of food allergies. We have a strict allergen control program in place. Out of the top 8 allergens, we only process wheat, barley, rye and farro. However, a complete cleaning, including a protein swab, is conducted after each run of any items containing gluten to remove any trace or cross-contamination.

ROUTINE PATHOGEN TESTING

Stahlbush continues to increase its spending on pathogen testing, education and training every year. We test routinely for pathogens such as: Listeria, Salmonella and E. Coli
